AND IT'S IMPACTING iDE
COMMUNITIES. HERE'S HOW.**

iDE

- **Children** risk missing out on school, as they enter the workforce to help their families. As a result, they are more likely to be forced into child labor and even child marriages, without the chance to learn skills needed to generate income on their own.
- **Families'** health outcomes often deteriorate, as they lose access to safe sanitation, menstrual pads, and prenatal health care.
- **Mothers** risk being unable to provide fresh nutrient-dense food and clean drinking water for their children.
- **Farmers** are in danger of losing access to finance to buy the next season's inputs, irrigation equipment, and fertilizer, agriculture services like ploughing, and market connections to sell their crops.
- **Young people**, some of whom are parents themselves, struggle to find a decent job. They could be forced to migrate and might be vulnerable to recruitment by extremist groups.

ETHIOPIA

In Ethiopia, iDE Boosts Economic Resilience But 725 Households May Still Lose Out

The loss of USAID funding will **affect 725 families**, leading to over **\$240,000 in lost livelihood savings**.

Impact on WASH:

- PPRESERVE Project: \$289,067 loss in funding
- WASHPals2: The cancellation of USAID's WASHPals2 research has resulted in a funding gap for the national-level sanitation subsidies research that iDE is currently implementing with Waterloo Foundation.

MADAGASCAR



iDE Madagascar Will Support 195,000 Families—But That Could All Stop.

iDE was set to support **195,000 households with 840,000 individuals**, but an estimated **\$27M of potential savings**, which would have been achieved through improved health outcomes, **could be lost for households facing poverty in Madagascar**. A devastating outcome after a highly successful first year.

Impact on WASH:

- Madagascar: Loss of new office (2024)—the first in a decade for iDE—which was entirely WASH x USAID funded.
- Rano Maharitra: \$1,904,055 loss in funding.
- Dio Sera: \$8,883,891 loss in funding.

iDE is driving sanitation markets in rural and underserved urban areas, empowering local businesses to restore dignity, improve health, and enhance nutrition for last-mile communities.

MOZAMBIQUE

Without iDE's USAID-funded programs in Mozambique, 408,000 people will remain in poverty

Some **62,000 rural farmers** could miss out on a combined \$70,000,000 in household income.

Impact on WASH: The cancellation of iDE's two major USAID programs has significantly impacted our staffing structure and operational capacity, putting at risk our two smaller WASH grants with World Vision and UNICEF.

BANGLADESH

In Bangladesh, 140,000 Families Could Miss Out On Potential Household Savings

\$88,000,000 in potential earnings is at risk for rural communities in Bangladesh's most remote areas.

Impact on WASH:

- **Bangladesh Nutrition Activity : \$1,238,798 loss of funds**

CAMBODIA

In Cambodia, iDE is building a market for WASH, but while impact grows, progress on poverty reduction, sustainability, and access is at risk for thousands of people

iDE has discovered and proven that there is a demand for sanitation services with an astounding **70% closing rate** in signing people up to receive waste collection services in the pilot district.

Impact on WASH:

- The cancellation of USAID funding is impacting iDE Cambodia's ability to pay national office staff roles, undermining the future of our Solid Waste Management work.
